- School officials should understand and uphold the laws, statutes, regulations and policies, related to bullying.

(Bully Police USA believes that positive interaction and problem solving between a bullied student and a school administrator is an important key to resolve bullying. Administrators must also deal with the behavioral problems of the bully.)

Each child is of great worth to Bully Police USA. It is important for a bullied child to feel that a fair decision has been made in his or her case, as well a just punishment/consequence for the bully's actions.

Bully Police U.S.A. Inc. would like to bring all volunteer groups, school anti bullying and harassment programs, and resources together.

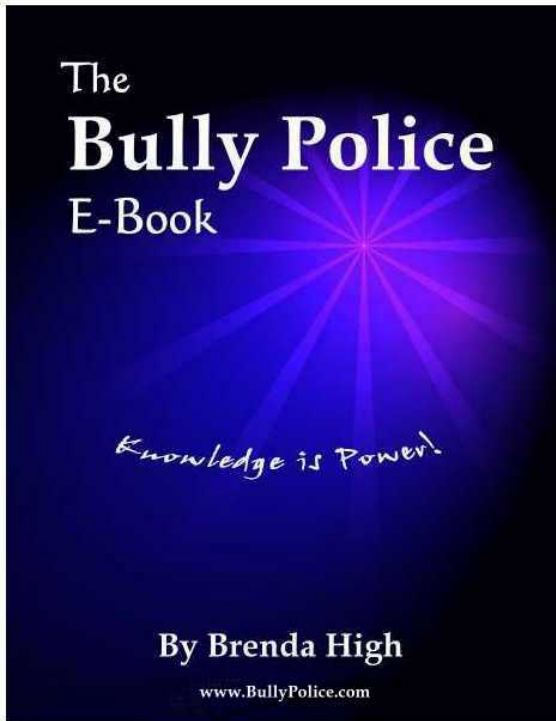
