Clients suicidal behaviors are a reality for mental health therapists and the source of distress for them. Yet, as a group research indicates that mental health professionals are "not adequately trained to provide proper assessment, treatment and management of suicidal patients." As a result, professionals have been calling for increased formal training in this area. The Statewide Office of Suicide Prevention is pleased to bring this training to Central Florida this fall.

Workshop Includes

- Pre-workshop reading (about 20 pages)
- 6.5 hours of face-to face training, comprised of an engaging mixture of lecture and exercises
- Training DVD in eight segments, highlighting competencies taught. Four of the segments are "live" demonstrations of a clinical interview between master clinician and researcher, David Jobes, Ph.D. and a professional actor.
- Over 110 pages of Participant Manual with an extensive bibliography organized by subject.
- Journaling spread through the day, allowing participants to reflect on their reactions to the course and to set goals for improving their practice and studying the topic further.
- Q & A and discussion.
- Awarding of CEUs (NASW & NBCC included, APA available for an additional \$35). The Suicide Prevention Resource Center is approved by the American Psychological Association to sponsor continuing education for psychologists. The Suicide Prevention Resource Center maintains responsibility for this program and its content.
